3 years ago, only
one company
reported selling
more than 5000
bikes. Now there
are **six**.

Van-free logistics.

87% of the companies use their cargo bike fleet for deliveries. Most of these are SMEs, creating **local jobs**.

More cargo bikes.

The average number of cargo bikes in a fleet has more than **quadrupled** since 2019.

Growing workforce.

Since 2019, the average number of company employees has **tripled**.

On average, nearly **a quarter** of them are women.

With this growth, we could easily see the cargo bike sector becoming one of the largest growth areas in green mobility. **The potential is far from being fully exploited.**
